

HISTORY HISTORY Steamer Stage To Watsonville Was Transport In 1857

Stages left Santa Cruz for Watsonville every week in 1857 departing on the arrival of the Steamer Santa Cruz and returning in time to connect with the steamer again before its departure for San Francisco.

The advertisement of the steamer service declared that the "New Steamer Santa Cruz, T. H. Dame, commander, will make regular trips for San Francisco on Thursday, leaving Santa Cruz at 8 o'clock p. m. Returning it leaves the Pacific street wharf for Santa Cruz on Tuesday at 8 o'clock a. m.

"The Santa Cruz will leave for Monterey the same evening of arrival, at 7 o'clock and returning will leave Monterey for Santa Cruz at 8 o'clock, a. m., touching at Soquel at 10 o'clock."
