Three Members Of Triton May Have Quit Voyage

Radio reports from the raft Triton indicate three of the six crewmembers have quit the cruise for good.

Larry White, Melvin Highley and Al Parvin are said to have left the raft, according to a radio broadcast from crewmember Doug Otis.

Otis said Parvin left in order to be with his pregnant wife, who now lives in Idaho. He apparently gave no explanation for the departure of the other two.

Otis revealed the loss of half his crew in a conversation by citizens band radio Friday with

his family in Fresno. The broadcast was also monitored in Watsonville by amateur operator Paul Miller.

Mrs. Tom Shanahan, wife of the Capitola wharf operator who is coordinating raft communications, said she had been told of

the conversation through a Fresno news man. Other radio receivers had also picked up garbled portions of the transmission, she said.

Otis indicated the remainder of his crew, Fred Hamenter and Dan McGee, plan to continue their trip to the South Pacific, eventually ending up in Australia.

White's wife, Maurine, said last night she had not heard from her husband and added, "I'm sure he would contact me fairly soon if he was quitting for any reason."

Highley's fiancée, Sue Esty of Capitola, also denied any knowl-

edge of the whereabouts of the three men.

The radio message said the raft was close to shore, about 150 miles north of the tip of Lower California and just off Point Cedros.
