

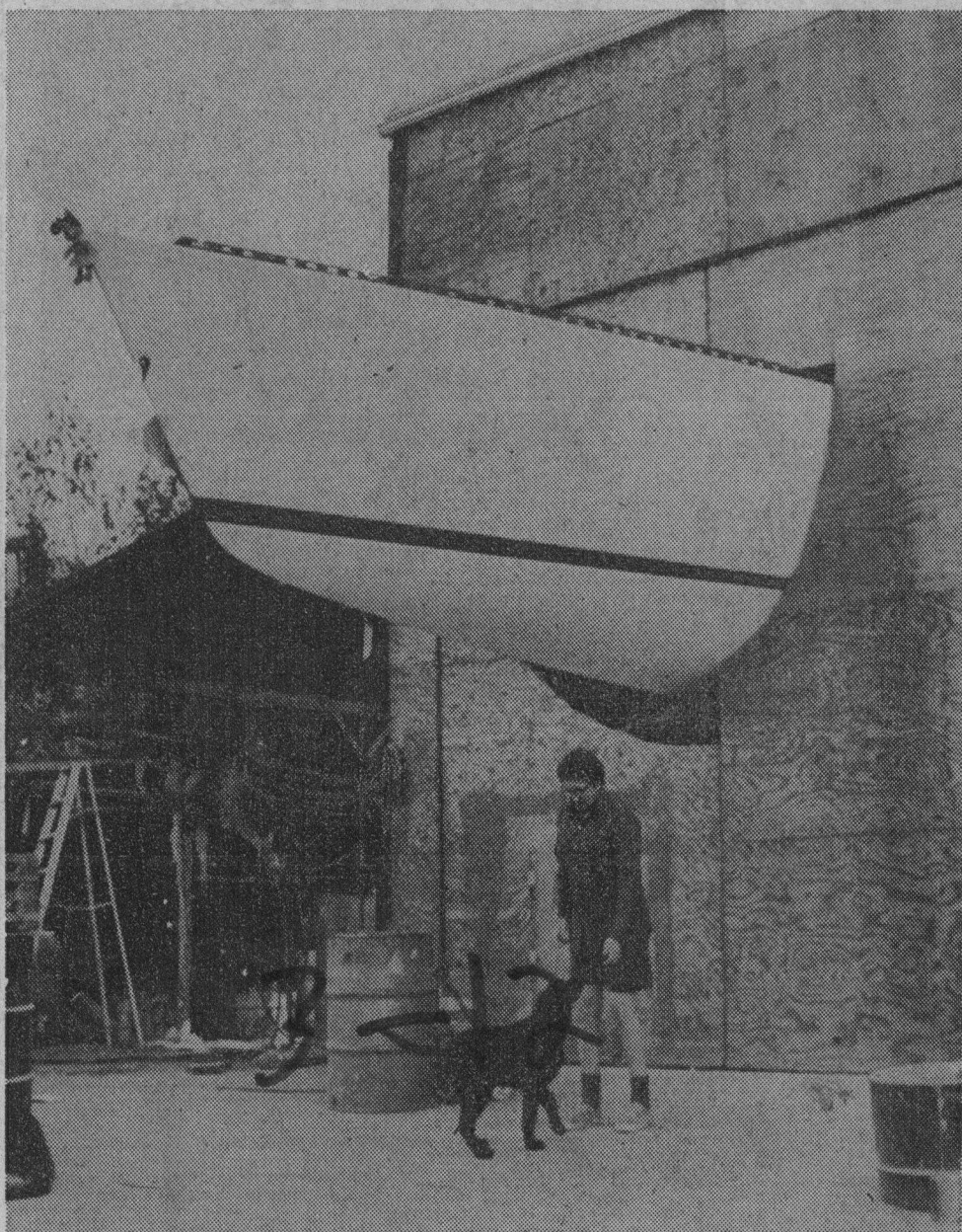

## Too Long For Shop
